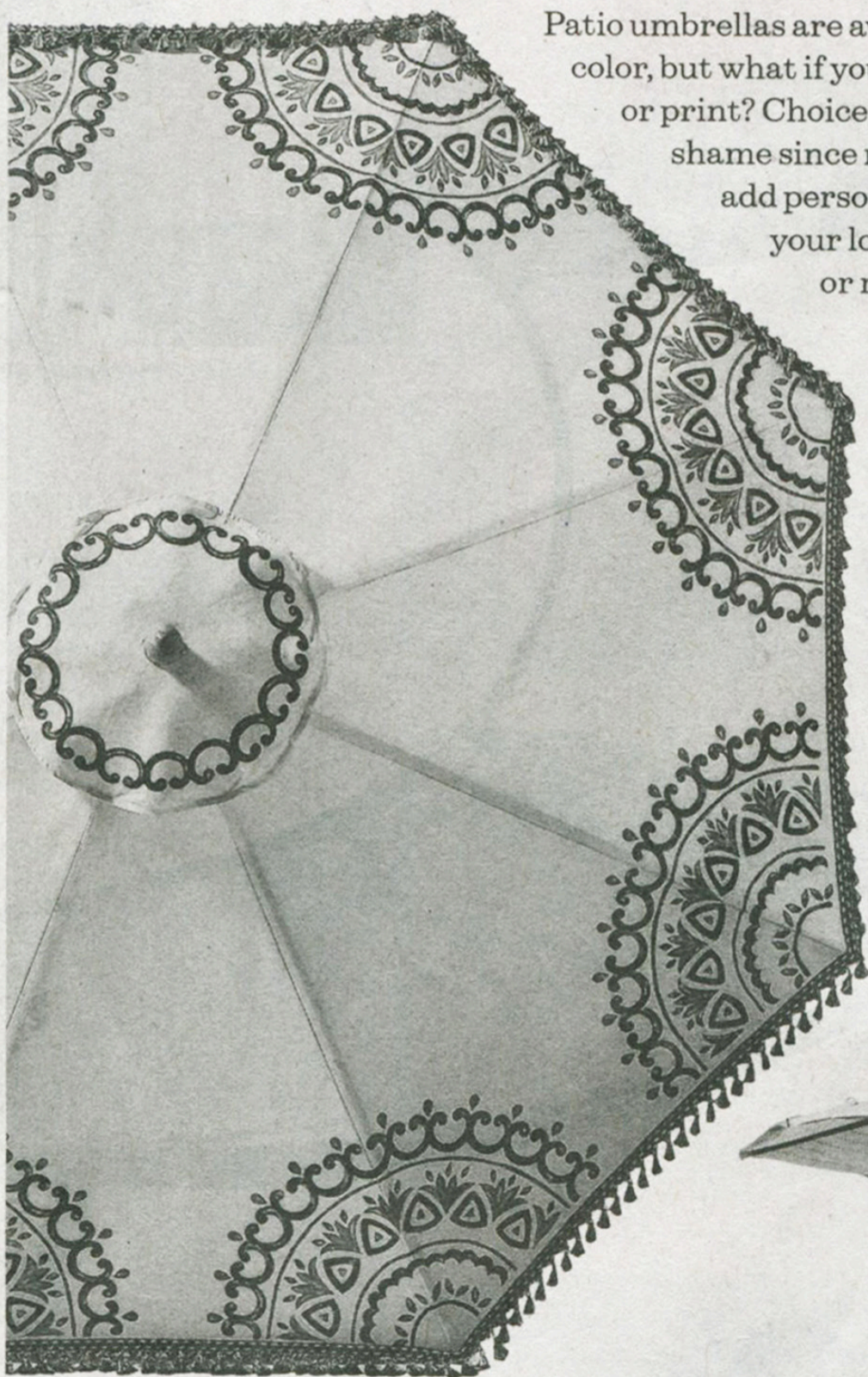

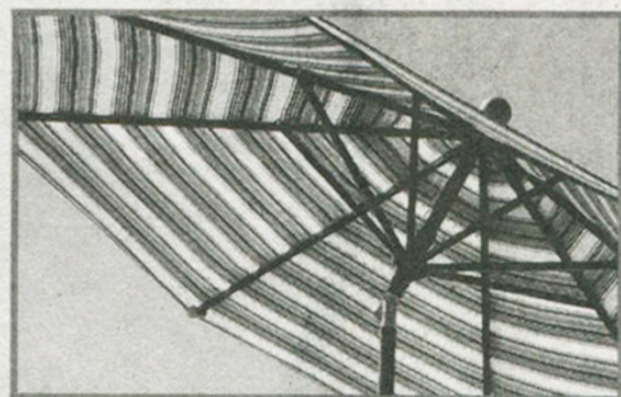

Frontgate

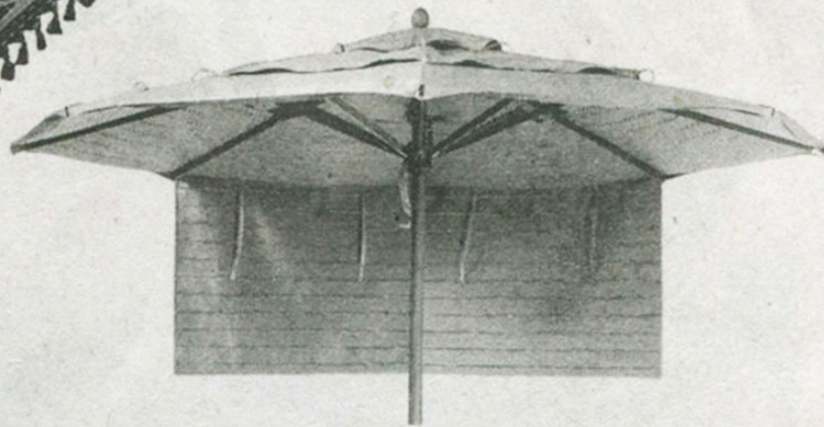
